Work Progress Report

ON THE ROAD

The crew repaired the shoulder of Rockford Bay Road where vehicle off-tracking has, for years, created an abrupt shoulder. This time the crew added asphalt to the width of the road to help mitigate the problem and placed a fog line.

Miller Road has been repaired where damage had occurred during a logging operation this summer. Those responsible for the damage provided the gravel necessary and paid to have the Magnesium-Chloride re-applied.

The Loffs Bay Road Participation Project is in full swing. The culverts were replaced prior to the placement of ballast rock. The ballast rock should be nearing completion this week. The gravel will be placed shortly after.

The crew finished sweeping the excess seal chips from the roads that were sealed this year.

Pavement markings were applied this month as well. With the increased efficiency of the seal coat process, the district was able to divide the crew to perform other tasks.

A couple of the district crew assisted Plummer-Gateway Highway District with their patching of asphalt. A few crewmen assisted East Side Highway District with their application of chip seal and painting pavement markings. Favors returned for their help this year.

Some of the winter maintenance equipment has been brought into the shop to begin servicing for the winter to head of us.

One tree had to be removed from Meadowbrook Loop because of gusting winds.
