# Kootenai County Community Development

# Farup Estates (Cottonwood Rd & Farup Rd) MIN 20-0099, minor subdivision:

It is now up to the applicant to circulate the Final Plate for signatures and request it be recorded. Kootenai County Community Development will check for recordation by May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025. No additional information this month.

# **CDA National Reserve, Major Subdivision:**

The current phase is complete. No inspections are required until another phase is brought forward. This subdivision will be removed from the staff report until such time as the developer brings forth a new addition.

# Clemetson Woods (Clemetson Rd) MIN22-0056, minor subdivision:

The district's review and comments have been noted to Kootenai County. The district's comments have been addressed except for payment of the "Payment in Lieu of Construction" (PILC) fees. This fee is due prior to the signing of the final plat. No additional information this month.

# Serenity View (Fox Haven Rd) MIN22-0028, 3 lot minor subdivision:

Recordation deadline is 11/01/2025. The final plat will need to come before the board for approval and the PILC's paid prior to signature.

# **WHD Construction Projects**

#### **Rockford Box Culvert:**

The easement acquisition is in process. Application for environmental permits and utility notices have been sent. The final design is the installation of an arched culvert pipe. The staff requests approval to go to bid.

Miller moved to proceed to advertising for bids, Johnson seconded. Cooper concurred. The motion passed unanimously.

# Rockford Bay Road/Loffs Bay Road (W) Intersection:

Discussion: recommendation for final payment.

Miller moved to make final payment of \$36, 625.54 for this project. Johnson seconded. Cooper concurred. The motion passed unanimously.

#### Greensferry Guardrail, Key No. 23285:

The final design has been reviewed by Worley Highway District and the Local Highway Technical Assistance Council (LHTAC). The final design, with changes from the review, will be completed in the near future and is on schedule.

# Kidd Island Road (Phase II):

It was made known yesterday that there is only one consulting firm that offered a proposal to take on the Kidd Island Phase 2 project. At this point it is just a formality of process until the award is made.

# Cougar Gulch Road:

There is a question as to the final material quantities (cut/fill and import) to be agreed on prior to final payment for the completed project.

# WHD Misc. Projects

#### Koth Road ROW Status:

Staff request conversation in an executive session to discuss a legal matter.

# **CDA Tribe, Lake Creek Project:**

The crossing at Idaho Road and a foundation design has been finalized to accommodate the soil strength. Coeur d'Alene Tribal Fisheries has ordered the structure to be installed. Construction is set to begin in 2025.

# **NEW BUSINESS**

# 1. Milhorn abandonment petition road #443

Seth and Barratt Milhorn have filed a petition for WHD to vacate/abandon road #443. Miller moved to accept the petition and set a public hearing date for January 22, 2025. Johnson seconded. Cooper concurred. The motion passed unanimously.

## 2. Kootenai Electric ROW dedication

Kevin informed the board of a potential right-of-way donation to the district. He explained the benefits it would have to the district if offered.

# 3. STBG-Rural application for Rockford Bay Rd.

Johnson moved to submit a STBG-Rural application for Rockford Bay Road for no more than \$3,000,000 requiring district matching funds of \$220,200 as part of a separate future year agreement. Miller seconded. Cooper concurred. The motion passed unanimously.

## 4. Accounts Payable

Miller moved that the bills be approved as presented on the A/P register. Johnson seconded. Cooper concurred. The motion passed unanimously.
