Work Progress Report

ON THE ROAD

The crew sand sealed the asphalt patches that were placed on the roads that were to be chip sealed. This helps ensure an even chip seal application when done.

Chip seals were applied to Bella Vista, Conkling Park Drive, Cottonwood and Chatcolet Roads. This process includes the sweeping of excess seal chips. The excess has become minimal with the use of the new chip spreader. This also helps decrease material expenses and increase productivity. The crew assisted Plummer -Gateway Highway District with its chip seal needs.

Pavement markings were applied this month as well. With the increased efficiency of the seal coat process, the district was able to divide the crew to perform other tasks.

The portion of Rolling Hills Road that was built last year received its first shot of High Float seal yesterday. A second shot will follow in about a week.

The Mica creek bridge deck has been paved and that project is complete.
