Construction has begun. The community is adjusting to the detour and all of the complications that have come along with it.

New Business Work Progress Report ON THE ROAD

The crew completed the buildup of Rockford Bay Road (graveled section) and applied the first Bituminous Surface Treatment (BST) as part of the paving process. This project has taken the majority of the crew and their time to prepare the roadbed by adding material and shaping the surface for paving.

The roadsides have been mowed. It is anticipated that some of the first roads mowed will need to be mowed again as we have had near record rainfall for the month and the grass is still growing.

Hot-mix asphalt patching is underway district wide. Patching first occurs on roadways with notable deficiencies and secondly as preparation for the following years seal coat. The road receiving the most attention (time and material) is Presley Road.

A tree root has been removed from Miller Road. It had grown large enough to cause issue with the road surface.

The road crew is continuing social distancing and sanitary practices due to the COVID-19 outbreak. Office staff is back in the office building and following CDC guidelines.

Planned work for this coming Month

- Asphalt road patching.
- Bituminous Surface Treatments (BST) High Float
- Seal Coats Chip and Fog.
