WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Worley Highway District, Kootenai County, Idaho, shall adopt RESOLUTION 2021-02 amending the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2020: Appropriating the sum of \$6,986,309.27, which sum includes an addition in expenditures by the Worley Highway District in the sum of \$492,462.27; repealing all budgets and parts of budget in conflict and providing an effective date hereof.

The Worley Highway District 2020- 2021 fiscal year budget, be and same hereby amended to read as follows:
